LORNE BUSH WALK: QUEENS PARK LOOP

This is one of the most beautiful walks on the coast through diverse environments. From tall trees right to the river and then the coast. If you would like to hear from an experienced guide, join Possum Pete.

BUSHWALK :ERSKINE RAPIDS WALK

Join Possum Pete on a nature walk along the Erskine River to the rapids area, spotting birds and identifying bush tucker along the way

BEACHCOMB

The ocean tells us a new story twice every day, when the tide goes out and leaves behind new things washed ashore. Some of these tell us of incredible creatures that can call the ocean home and their lucky escapes (or not!) from predators. We'll explore the incredible diversity of seaweed and even the geology of the coastline. We might find some things that don't belong on the beach or in the ocean, so we'll tidy them up along the way, too.

ROCKPOOL RAMBLE

A world unlike any other, able to be explored only during the low tide and home to some of the most interesting creatures on the planet. Come and tickle a crab or touch a seastar, wear something better than thongs though or you might fall in!
